1st Person - ay + ay + ay (Munay, Verb+ay, Che)

2nd Person - ay

3rd Person - ay

Possessive:

1st Person - (Maru/e/o, Che)

2nd Person - (Ta(ma)ru/e/o + Che)

3rd Person - (Aynu/e/o, Che)

Future Tense:

1st Person - oo + ees (Hoon,, Verb+ees)

2nd Person - oo + ees (Tu, Verb+ees)

3rd Person - ay + say (Te, Verb+say)
